- Avoid excessive use of sunscreen



Swimming

For safety reasons, it is strongly advised to stay on the main course of Fango and not raise its tributaries. Moreover, swimming on unsupervised beach Riciniccia is forbidden in case of bad weather.

Spare-time activities and hiking

The biosphere Reserve is crossed by many hiking trails. Secondly, Galeria also offers water-related activities for your enjoyment (delta ecological discovery by kayaking, scuba diving, boat rentals, etc).



Vigilance flood

During the summer, mountain storms can cause a rapid water rising. Be vigilant and follow the safety instructions in case of evacuation by the emergency services.

Management of tourists flows and fire risk

For your safety and to enjoy your visit into the valley, please follow the instructions and regulations. Please be mindful of the residents here and do not park your car in the villages and/or hamlets.

To facilitate the access of emergency services in case of fire, please follow the signs prohibiting parking along the road.

If a fire breaks out, adopt the following behavior:

- Take refuge on the car parks and areas provided
- Carefully follow the instructions of emergency services.

Biosphere Reserve of the Fango Valley

Created in 1977, it extends from Riciniccia beach to the Punta Minuta (2556 meters) and corresponds to the Fango river watershed, mountain stream flowing into the Gulf of Galeria. With its 26,825 hectares, we can observe all stages of a valley landscape with pronounced Mediterranean characteristics.

This unique space gets the imprint of man through an old farming activity. Today, human activity is very discreet with 450 inhabitants living in the various hamlets of Galeria, Manso and Calenzana commons. The local economy is based on agriculture and summer tourism.

This global network of unique territories, called biosphere Reserves, was created under the auspices of international scientific program Man and Biosphere (MAB) of UNESCO.
